Each of her creations has a story, and she envisioned them in lace, using colored and gold threads, often incorporating Plexiglass into the structure. Her collection not only includes these masterpieces but also a large number of antique lace pieces. We plan to open the exhibit in mid-April, with a firm date to follow.
